Objectives and Investment Policy

Franklin K2 Athena UCITS Fund (the “Fund”) aims to increase the value of its investments with lower volatility relative to broader equity markets and less correlation to traditional asset classes over the medium to long term.

The Fund pursues an actively managed investment strategy and invests mainly in:

- risk premia strategies which are systematic trading strategies based on quantitative analysis of price and fundamental data, through the use of internal or external algorithms.

The Fund intends to gain exposure, either directly or indirectly (through mutual funds, exchange-traded funds, derivatives or structured products), to a wide range of transferable securities, derivatives (for investment purposes, such as total return swaps), FX forwards (an exchange of a pair of currencies at a set rate on a future date) as well as other securities including but not limited to equity and equity-related securities (including participatory notes and convertible securities), debt securities of any quality of sovereign issuers worldwide, currencies as well as other eligible securities. The investment team may decide to invest all of the Fund's assets in debt securities issued by the EU, OECD, Singapore or other G20 member state.

The benchmark of the Fund is the EURIBOR 3-Month Index. The benchmark

is used solely as a reference for Investors to compare against the Fund's performance. The Fund is not obliged to hold any of the benchmark constituents and may indeed invest up to 100% of its net assets outside the benchmark.

You may request the sale of your shares on any Luxembourg business day.

The income received from the Fund's investments is accumulated with the result of increasing the value of the shares.

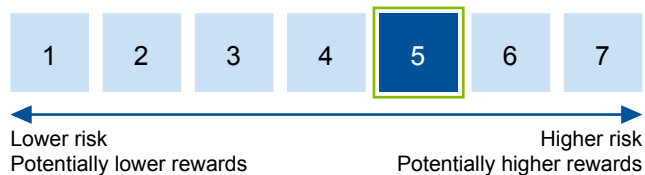

Terms to Understand

Convertible Securities: debt securities that, when they mature, offer the investor the option of receiving either cash or a pre-determined number of the issuer's equity securities at a predefined date.

Derivatives: Financial instruments whose characteristics and value depend on the performance of one or more underlying assets, typically securities, indexes, currencies or interest rates.

Why is the Fund in this specific category?

The Fund intends to achieve its objective by investing in a wide range of eligible securities and derivatives benefiting from various risk premia strategies. Such securities and investment instruments have historically been subject to price movements, generally due to interest rates, perceived credit worthiness of securities issuers, or other movements in the bond, equity and/or currency markets. As a result, the performance of the Fund

can fluctuate considerably over time.

Risks materially relevant not adequately captured by the indicator:

Counterparty risk: the risk of failure of financial institutions or agents (when serving as a counterparty to financial contracts) to perform their obligations, whether due to insolvency, bankruptcy or other causes.

Credit risk: the risk of loss arising from default that may occur if an issuer fails to make principal or interest payments when due. This risk is higher if the Fund holds low-rated, sub-investment-grade securities.

Derivative Instruments risk: the risk of loss in an instrument where a small change in the value of the underlying investment may have a larger impact on the value of such instrument. Derivatives may involve additional liquidity, credit and counterparty risks.

Foreign Currency risk: the risk of loss arising from exchange-rate fluctuations or due to exchange control regulations.

Substantial Leverage risk: the risk that the permitted use of a substantial degree of leverage may cause a Fund to liquidate portfolio positions to satisfy its obligations when it may not be advantageous to do so. As a result, a relatively small price movement in a derivative contract, may result in substantial losses to a Fund.

Operational risk: the risk of losses resulting from errors or failures arising from the people, systems, service providers or processes upon which the Fund depends.

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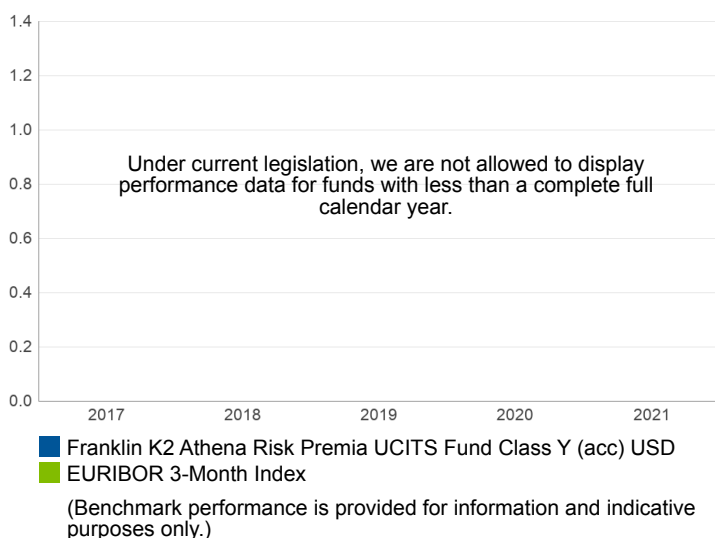
